Reference: **Hebrews 11:1**, “Now faith is the substance of things hoped for (and) the evidence of things not seen.”

The word faith essentially means “to believe, to trust, to put reliance and confidence in”.

There are three different aspects to faith:

- _____ (acknowledge); faith begins with an awareness about what should be believed.
- _____; faith agrees that the potential object of faith is actually true.
- _____; faith means a personal commitment and reliance on the object of faith.

Faith can be divided into two basic categories: human faith and divine faith.
