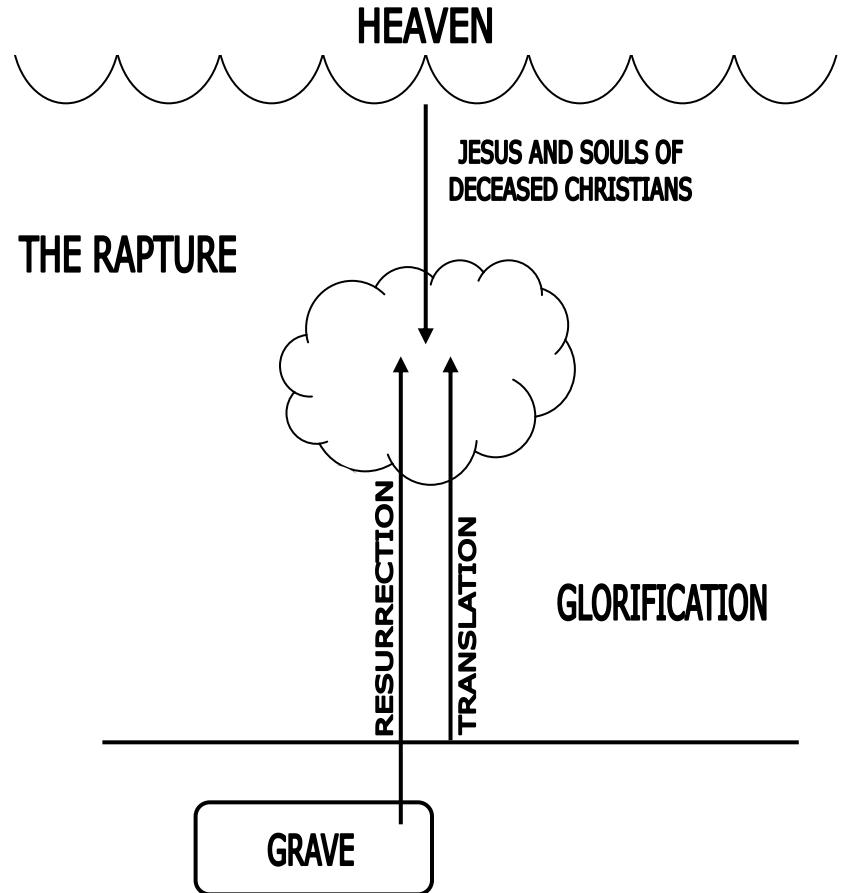

Definition: glorification is a theological term meaning at the rapture Christians are transformed into a _____ form that enables them to survive and thrive in heaven.

There are two phases to the rapture: deceased Christians are _____ and Christians that are still alive are _____.



Reference: **I John 3:2**, *“Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed (when Jesus is revealed at the rapture) we shall be like Him (i.e. Jesus) for we shall see Him as He is.”*

During the rapture, Christians are scheduled to be glorified meaning to receive Jesus-like bodies. Those new bodies will resemble the body Jesus received immediately after His resurrection from the dead.
