## THE LIE THAT PROVES THE RESURRECTION

Reference: I Corinthians 15

verse fourteen, "And if Christ is not risen (if there was no resurrection), then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty." verse seventeen, "And if Christ is not risen (if there was no resurrection), (then) your faith is futile (and) you are still in your sins!"

This argument states that the disciples stole His body in order to deceive people into thinking He had been resurrected and in fact, He hadn't.

Reference: Matthew 28:11-15

**verse eleven**, "Now while they (the women who had just seen Jesus in His resurrected state) were going, behold, some of the guard came into the city (Jerusalem) and reported to the chief priests all the things that had happened."

verse twelve, "When they (chief priests) had assembled with the elders and consulted together, they gave a large sum of money to the soldiers." verse thirteen, "saying, 'Tell them, 'His disciples came at night and stole Him away while we slept.""

**verse fourteen**, "'And if this comes to the governor's ears (Pontus Pilate) we will appease him and make you secure.""

**verse fifteen**, "So they took the money and did as they were instructed; and this saying is commonly reported among the Jews until this day."

This outrageous lie forced people to re-examine the resurrection and a logical, biblical and historical examination of Christ's resurrection proves that the body was not stolen. The four reasons it couldn't have been stolen just reinforce the fact Jesus was resurrected from the dead.
