## **QUESTION: WHEN DOES HUMAN LIFE BEGIN?** Reference: miscellaneous Scripture Pastor Larry Webb

On January 22, 1973, in the legal case of Roe versus Wade, the US Supreme Court justices voted (7-2) to legalize abortion and that ruling continued until June 24, 2022 when Roe versus Wade was overturned. The determining question between the opposing sides of the abortion debate is: at what moment does actual individual human life begin? Just when does personhood start?

The purpose of this message is to attempt to answer that question.

Definition: **Conception** is the actual \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the male sperm and the female egg or ovum.

Definition: An embryo is an unborn child from the moment of conception through the trimester (i.e. the first three months of pregnancy.)

Definition: A fetus is an unborn child through the \_\_\_\_\_ and trimesters (i.e. the remainder of the pregnancy.)

Five biblical statements (there are more!) that support the basic contention that human life begins at conception:

**ONE:** The Bible does not make a \_\_\_\_\_\_ between an unborn child and a child after birth.

This word translated "babe" is from the Greek word

" " and that ancient word was used to describe John the Baptist in his prenatal unborn state.

Reference: Acts 7:19 (see screen)

Stephen used the word "babies" to describe those infant boys born to Jewish mothers that were then drowned. It's translated from that same Greek word " ."

Luke was completely aware of the fact he used the same Greek word to describe a child in the \_\_\_\_\_ position and then a child in the position.

**TWO:** To argue that someone does not become a person until birth is to say that God forms \_\_\_\_\_ inside the womb.

**THREE:** In the Old Testament, if a man injured a pregnant woman to the

extent that her unborn child died, then the principle of for would be put into effect. Reference: Exodus 21:22-23 (see screen) The point is that this man that had caused this fatal injury be required to give his life for the life of the child if that child wasn't considered a human life. FOUR: The universal physical reproduction law states that each thing is to reproduce after . Reference: Genesis 1:11-12 (see screen) This phrase, "according to its kind" is repeated ten different times in Genesis chapter one. This is called the **law of** \_\_\_\_\_, and teaches that each thing reproduces after itself. That means personhood cannot reproduce non-personhood. FIVE: Conception is the generating agent for the Reference: **Psalm 51:5** (see screen) The sin nature is this internal invisible susceptibility humans have toward committing sin that we have all inherited from the first man, Adam.(sometimes called the flesh, the Adamic nature, or the old man). The result of this sin nature are the practical sins we commit. The point is that this sin nature we receive at conception is passed on to persons, not \_\_\_\_\_\_. Three things to consider for those that have experienced or have contributed to an abortion. Understand that the nature of God is to \_\_\_\_\_ no matter what we might have done.

Reference: **Psalm 103:8** and **11** (see screen) It is important to understand that our sin will never be greater than God's grace and mercifulness.
