Three Observations:

- God laid out a particular prophetic period of time consisting of seventy weeks or better stated in a literal sense as seventy _____ of _____.
- This particular prophetic text has a direct _____ to the Jewish people and Jerusalem.
- The events that are prophesied to occur during this seventy-week period have been divided into three segments: the first segment is _____ weeks in length, the second segment is _____-_____ weeks, and the third segment is _____ week.

We cannot begin to understand this prophecy until we determine the meaning of the phrase "seventy weeks." Throughout these verses the Hebrew word that is translated as "weeks" literally means "_____ of seven."

The overwhelming consensus is that these units of seven are seven _____. That means that seventy weeks or seventy units of seven equals _____ years.

- *"to bring in everlasting righteousness"* This word *"righteousness"* characterizes the _____ and then goes into the eternal age.

- *"to seal up vision and prophecy"* This means all prophecies related to Israel will be _____ at the Messiah's return to the earth to establish His rule throughout the millennium. .
- *"and to anoint the Most Holy"* This is a reference to the dedication of the _____ of _____ inside the millennial temple as described in **Ezekiel 41-46**.
