"The Church at Ephesus - Part II" Reference: Revelation 2:4, 5 and 7 Pastor Larry Webb

Each of the letters to the seven churches in ancient Asia Minor (modern western Turkey) contains four basic components: commendation, condemnation, counsel and a challenge.

COMMENDATION:

Jesus commended the Church at Ephesus on 6 different things:

- the congregations commitment to laboring for Jesus
- the congregations exercising patience (spiritual endurance)
- the congregations refusal to tolerate evil people
- the congregations identification of spiritual phonies
- the congregations hatred of the Nicolaitan deeds
- the congregations determined perseverance
