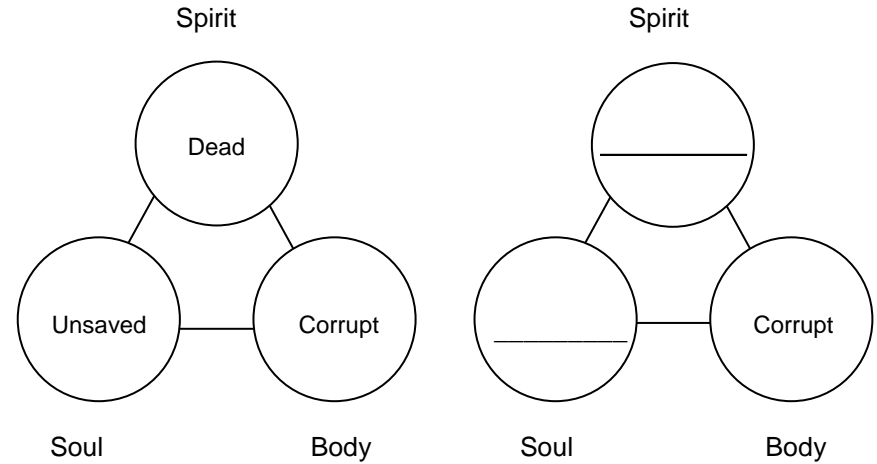
**Biblical arguments that teach salvation is secure:**
