

**III JOHN - Part 2**

There are **three men** mentioned in this small book: **Gaius** in **verses 1-8**, **Diotrephes** in **verses 9 and 10** and **Demetrius** in **verse 12**.

**verse ten**, *“Therefore, if I come, I will call to mind his deeds which he does...”*

John goes on to mention four things (deeds) that Diotrephes did. He was:

**One** *“prating against us with malicious words”*

Reference: **I Timothy 5:19** and **20** (see screen)

Three basic rules we should consider before we make a comment about someone else

- Is something \_\_\_\_\_
- Is something \_\_\_\_\_
- Is something \_\_\_\_\_

**Two** *“...and not content with that, he himself does not receive the brethren”*

Remember Gaius \_\_\_\_\_ people and Diotrephes \_\_\_\_\_ people.

**Three** *“...and forbids those who wish to”*

**Four...** *“...putting them out of the church”*

Diotrephes was a cantankerous miserable human being! There are certain things someone can do that almost guarantee becoming that miserable.

- Be preoccupied with \_\_\_\_\_ about ourselves
- Be preoccupied with \_\_\_\_\_ about ourselves
- Expect \_\_\_\_\_ and get upset if it doesn't happen
- Be \_\_\_\_\_ and even cynical of others
- Be \_\_\_\_\_ of others' positions, possessions, and particular abilities
- Never forgive and/or forget a \_\_\_\_\_

- Push and push to get others to \_\_\_\_\_ with our thoughts and opinions
- Base our \_\_\_\_\_ on how others see us and not on who we are in Christ
- Practice \_\_\_\_\_ and do only the bare minimum for others

But Diotrephes' core problem is mentioned in **verse nine**, *“...but Diotrephes, who loves to have the preeminence among them...”*

The **third gentleman** mentioned in this small book is **Demetrius**, in one sentence, Demetrius \_\_\_\_\_ people.

There are two men in the New Testament named Demetrius: one is mentioned in **Acts 19:24-41** and then the second Demetrius mentioned here in **verse twelve**. Demetrius attracted people because he had such an outstanding reputation.

**verse twelve**, *“Demetrius has a good testimony from all, and from the truth itself. And we also bear witness, and you know that our testimony is true”.*
