## *Isaiah Sees God*

### Isaiah 6:1

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple.

He is exalted above all else, there is \_\_\_\_\_ like Him!

### Isaiah 6:2

Above it stood seraphim: each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew

The seraphim demonstrate \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ while in His presence.

## Isaiah 6:3-4

And one cried to another and said: “HOLY, HOLY, HOLY is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!” and the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke”.

This is who God is, He is totally \_\_\_\_\_ from His creations, He is **HOLY, HOLY, HOLY**

**HOLY = “to cut or to separate”**

## *Isaiah Sees himself*

### Isaiah 6:5

“So I said Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.”

He had received an image from God that made him experience a strong sense of guilt and it caused him an extreme awareness of the judgment that he \_\_\_\_\_.

**WOE is me!**



*Isaiah sees and receives cleansing  
and is prepared for service*

Isaiah 6:6-7

“Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar. And he touched my mouth with it, and said: Behold, this has touched your lips; Your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged.”

This is an incredible illustration of God’s \_\_\_\_\_; He gave Isaiah something he did not deserve. This was **divine grace**, something ONLY GOD GIVES, and cannot be earned.
