Definition: Messianic prophecies were predictions made about the promised Jewish Messiah centuries before the Messiah would be born.

Cannon Lidden counted **332** Old Testament passages that contain detailed Messianic prophecies; **60** of which are considered major Messianic prophecies.

Reference: **Micah 5:2**, (8th century BC) "*But you, **Bethlehem Ephrathah**, though you are little among the thousands of Judah yet **out of you shall come forth to Me the One to be Ruler in Israel** (Messiah)...*"

Messianic Prophecy Two: The Messiah would be preceded by a _____.

Reference: **Isaiah 40:3** (8th century BC), "***The voice of one crying in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the LORD; make straight in the desert a highway for our God.'***"

Messianic Prophecy Three: The Messiah would enter _____ on a _____.

*“We find that the chance that any man might have lived down to the present time and fulfilled all eight prophecies is one chance in ten to the seventeenth power. The chance of these eight prophecies being fulfilled in anyone else (other than Jesus) is **one chance in ten to the seventeenth power.**”* Professor Peter Stoner

Footnote: **Ten** to the **seventeenth power** is the number one and seventeen zeroes after it. It is the number one hundred million billion, i.e. _____.

In a historical sense the ancient Jewish people rejected Jesus (Yeshua) as the promised Messiah and insisted that the Roman government execute Him. It was a collaborated effort on the part of the Jewish religious authorities and the Roman government together that resulted in committing the crime of the ages.

But the exciting part is that in the prophetic future after Jesus returns to this earth, the entire Jewish nation, and individual Jewish people are going to accept Him this time as their Messiah.
