This is an often-ignored parable called the parable of “*the growing seed.*”

verse twenty-six, “*And He (Jesus) said, ‘The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground,’*”

verse twenty-seven, “*and should sleep by night and rise by day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he himself does not know how.*”

verse twenty-eight, “*For the earth yields crops by itself: first the blade, then the head, after that the full grain in the head.*”

verse twenty-nine, “*But when the grain ripens, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come.*”

Principle one is that we reap _____

The seed in this parable represents the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Definition: *The gospel of Jesus Christ is the good news that Jesus Christ died for our sins, was buried, and was resurrected from the dead and through believing on Him we can receive salvation.*

Principle Two is that we reap _____

This second law states that someone doesn’t reap immediately after the seed is sown, because it requires *time* for germination to occur.
