**verses one through ten** (see screen)

Exposition:

**verse four** (see screen)

The word “but” is typically used to introduce a clause \_\_\_\_\_ with what has already been mentioned. Essentially this “but God” statement is making it clear that **God is \_\_\_\_\_ than man.**

Mercy, **pity**, and \_\_\_\_\_ are roughly synonymous. References: **Psalm 103:8; Psalm 51:1; Psalm 59:5; Isaiah 55:7; Matthew 20:30** (see screen)

God’s mercy is pictured not only as God’s disposition but as **His \_\_\_\_\_ on behalf of an undeserving people.** References: **Psalm 103:10** (see screen)

**God’s great love** is not something that is based on how well we perform as Christians. It is simply \_\_\_\_\_ to us **because of His rich mercy**, despite our rebelliousness.

**verses five and six** (see screen)

The term “*even when*” is used to make explicit an \_\_\_\_\_ **situation that might be thought of as an exception.**

Grace is \_\_\_\_\_ or kindness **shown without regard to the worth or merit** of the one who receives it and despite what that person deserves.

Glory means **beauty, power**, or \_\_\_\_\_.

Glory is used in three ways in the Bible:

- God's moral beauty and perfection as a \_\_\_\_\_  
**presence**, something that has been seen as fire or dazzling light.
