Ahasuerus servants suggested some specific steps to finding a suitable replacement to Vashti. Each step starts with the word "let."

- ____ to start a search process verse two. "...'Let beautiful young virgins be sought for the king;"
- men in the different provinces to find and bring eligible virgins to the palace verse three, "and let the king appoint officers in all the provinces of his kingdom, that they may gather all the beautiful young virgins to Shushan the citadel, into the women's guarters, under the custody of Hegai the king's eunuch, custodian of the women..."
- the virgins to be presented to Ahasuerus verse three continued "...And let beauty preparations be given them.""
- have the women to please Ahasuerus verse four, "Then let the young woman who pleases the king be queen instead of Vashti.' ... "

Five important principles from this selection process:

Principle: Beatification happens both on the and

verse seven, "The young woman was lovely and beautiful."

verse fifteen, "...And Esther obtained favor in the sight of all who saw her."

verse seventeen, "...she obtained grace and favor in his sight more than all the virgins;"

Principle: ______ earns great dividends.

verse seven, "And Mordecai had brought up Hadassah, that is, Esther, his uncle's daughter, for she had neither father nor mother. The young woman was lovely and beautiful. When her father and mother died, Mordecai took her as his own daughter."

Principle: is critical.

verse ten, "Esther had not revealed her people or family, for Mordecai had charged her not to reveal it."

Principle: is attractive.

verse fifteen, "Now when the turn came for Esther the daughter of Abihail the uncle of Mordecai, who had taken her as his daughter, to go in to the king, she requested nothing but what Hegai the king's eunuch, the custodian of the women. advised."
