## **Exposition:**

Verse One (see screen) Who is that Paul is talking about? He is specifically talking about Gentiles who became

Reference: Ephesians 1:13 (see screen)

Paul has just described the **human** \_\_\_\_\_ (*dead in trespasses and sins*), and he has described the \_\_\_\_\_ **of salvation** (*made alive*).

Why am I here according to the course of this world? According to this worldview people want to live in a way that **glorifies** \_\_\_\_\_\_.

What does a good life look like according to the course of this world?

According to the course of this world a good life according to the world depends on your \_\_\_\_\_. A good life is subjective.

What does a good life look like according to the Bible? According to the Bible, a good life is about **loving**

Do other people matter or only me according to the world?

Do other people matter or only me according to the Bible?

According to the Bible the value of people is

**Principle Three**: (v. 3) Christians \_\_\_\_\_ conducting themselves in the lust of the flesh, but now should not. Reference: **1 Peter 5:8-9**
