Praying is mentioned in each one of these verses and those instances are related to three specific categories of hurts we might experience.
ONEwe should pray if we're hurting in an sense. verse thirteen, "Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray"
TWOwe should pray if we're hurting in a sense. verse fourteen, "Is anyone among you sick?"

Fact one: God Fact two: is healed.
Here's a biblical prescription for someone that has contracted a serious illness.
Step one is to acknowledge that God is (He's in control.) Reference: Deuteronomy 32:39 , "Now see that I, even I, am He, and there is no God besides Me; I kill and I make alive; I wound and I heal"
Step two is to seek medical attention.
Probably the strongest biblical evidence that God intended for his people to use medical means are the health aspects of the Mosaic legislation.
