The phrase "to find favor" means that someone would find us, i.e. someone would accept us, admire us, respect us and even bless us in some sense.
To find favor with God means that God has laid His hand on us and intends to do something in, through and for us. Reference: <b>Acts 11:19-21</b> (see screen)
Question: How does someone earn favor with both God and man?  Answer: Someone earns favor with both God and man through a consistent commitment to being both (love) an
Reference: <b>Proverbs 3:3-4</b> ; <b>Psalm 85:10</b> , <b>86:15</b> , <b>89:14</b> (see screen)
Merriam Webster defines truth as: Onethe real facts about something, i.e Twothe quality or state of being consistent with facts, i.e
<b>Definition</b> : Truth is that which is with God Himself.
God is called the God of truth ( <b>Deuteronomy 32:4</b> and <b>Isaiah 65:16</b> ). God is called the Lord God of truth ( <b>Psalm 31:5</b> ). God

requires we worship Him in truth (John 4:24). Jesus, as the God man, said, "I am the truth" (John 14:6). God's Word itself is truth (John 17:17). The Holy Spirit is called the Spirit of truth (John 16:13). I John 5:20 reads (see screen).
