"God is Omnipresent"

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Reference: **Psalm 139:7-10; I Kings 8:27** (see screen)

**Short Definition:** God is omnipresent means \_\_\_\_\_.

**Long Definition:** God's omnipresence means that His complete essence is fully present in all places \_\_\_\_\_.

Three statements that can help us better understand the omnipresence of God:

- God's presence is \_\_\_\_\_ from the \_\_\_\_\_. He has created.

God's omnipresence is not the same as pantheism.

Pantheism is the belief that God is an \_\_\_\_\_ part of the material universe.

Pantheism is refuted in **I Kings 19:9-12; Jeremiah 23:24** (see screen)

- God's presence is unique in that all of Him \_\_\_\_\_ everywhere; but, not all of Him is \_\_\_\_\_ in the same sense everywhere.

Reference: **Psalm 11:4** (see screen)

- Even though God is equally \_\_\_\_\_ everywhere, He is not equally \_\_\_\_\_ to everyone, meaning there is an equality of His essence but not of His relationship.

References: **Isaiah 55:6; Psalm 34:18, Psalm 73:28, Psalm 145:18; James 4:8** (see screen)

Although everyone experiences the essential omnipresence of God, Christians enjoy the special \_\_\_\_\_ presence of God.

References: **Romans 8:11; Colossians 1:27; I Corinthians 6:19**

The fact God is omnipresent means He is able to do at least four specific things for us.

**Because God is present with me in a relational sense:**

ONE... He will \_\_\_\_\_ us \_\_\_\_\_.
