Some problematic symptoms from demonic oppression are:

- _____ - i.e. sleeplessness, nightmares, severe anxiousness, self-mutilation, addictions, and different sicknesses and diseases, etc.
- _____ - i.e. this apathetic spiritual attitude and even anger toward God; paranormal phenomena such as doors opening and shutting, hearing footsteps and even voices, etc.
- _____ - i.e. unusual financial pressure, especially if there is a rapid succession of unexpected financial disasters.

- _____ - i.e. frequent outbursts of anger, emotional instability going from high highs to low lows often, hopelessness and abnormal fear and paranoia, etc.

There are certain things someone can do to invite demonic oppression:

- Past or present participation in _____ such as: Ouija boards, tarot cards, astrology, séances, necromancy (contacting dead spirits) and divination.
- Past or present participation in _____: **I Timothy 4:1** states false religions ultimately teach the doctrines of demons.
- _____ use: Drugs can alter the state of someone's mind and that can be an invitation to demonic influence.
- Occult _____ techniques: The new age teaching that we should empty our minds and then repeat some continuous strange mantra can result in losing personal control of our faculties and is an open invitation to demonic influence.
- _____ from other people: Curses and spells can be focused on someone and if not countered can have a negative and sometimes deadly effect.
