Dr. George W. Truett pastored Dallas First Baptist Church for almost a half century. He once summarized the essence of the Christian experience in this statement "To know the will of God is the greatest and then to do the will of God is the greatest
The problem is before someone can do the will of God he must first know the will of God.
Definition : God's determinative will is that which He has will occur.
