verse ten, "Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent?"

verse eleven, "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!**"

Reference: **Romans 8:32**

verse thirty two, "He who did not spare His own Son (God the Father), but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He (God the Father) not with Him (God's Son, Jesus) **also freely give us all things?**"
